

Mouse TNFRSF11A/Rank Protein

Description

Source	Recombinant Mouse TNFRSF11A/Rank Protein is expressed from HEK293 with hFc tag at the C-Terminus. It contains Val31-Ser214.
Accession	O35305
Molecular Weight	The protein has a predicted MW of 47.0 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 57-67 kDa based on Bis-Tris PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Bis-Tris PAGE > 95% as determined by HPLC

Formulation and Storage

Formulation	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
Storage	-20 to -80°C for 12 months as supplied from date of receipt. -80°C for 3 months after reconstitution. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background

TNFRSF11A, also known as receptor activator of NF-κB (RANK), activates several signaling pathways, such as NF-κB, JNK, ERK, p38α, and Akt/PKB. RANK/TNFRSF11A is a novel and frequent target for de novo methylation in gliomas, which affects apoptotic activity and focus formation thereby contributing to the molecular pathogenesis of gliomas.

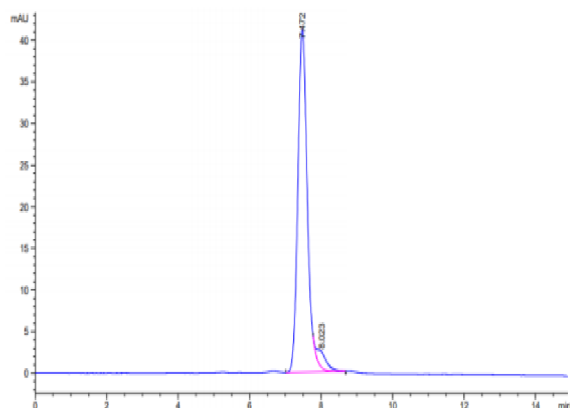

SEC-HPLC



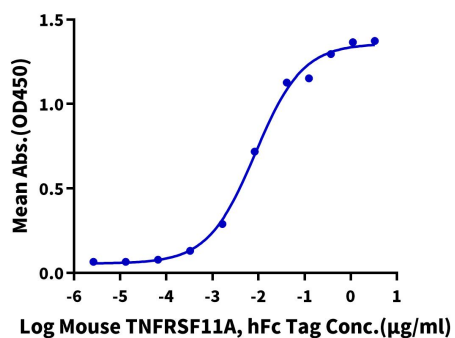
The purity of Mouse TNFRSF11A is greater than 95% as determined by SEC-HPLC.
